A visit to Aix-en-Provence, known for amazing French-Mediterranean cuisine, trendy boutiques, Cézanne's Impressionist art influences, and nearby lavender fields will make this journey an even more unforgettable one. Pack your bags and explore these stylish places in the south of France. Dive into the French style of living, relax on the beaches, paddle in the azure sea, then sip on a smooth cocktail beneath swaying palms and discover the magic.

#### DAY 2 LAND TOUR START DAY: SAINT-RAPHAEL

Welcome to the Côte d'Azur. Ever since the author Stéphen Liégeard published the book 'La Côte d'Azur' in 1887, the name stuck to this glamorous stretch of the Mediterranean coast, the French Riviera. Enjoy free time to get acquainted with your surroundings before joining your tour director and fellow travelers for a welcome orientation and dinner of French specialties. Let the adventure begin!

#### DAY 3 CANNES

We travel to Cannes by train today to visit this beautiful ritzy town famous for its annual film festival, great shopping, excellent food, and long golden, sandy beach along the famous La Croisette Promenade. Get a true behind-the-scenes look on our tour led by a screenwriter and historical researcher. Following our guide across the city—from local markets to beaches; through the old town and beyond—we learn about how this quiet fishing district became home to the world's most celebrated film festival and celebrity hangout. Afterwards, enjoy time walking among the designer bars, couture shops and palaces while admiring Ferraris and Porsches or even spotting some celebrities on a posh yacht along the way. Then we're in for a special treat as we board our luxury catamaran and sail along the Bay of Cannes while relaxing on deck. Take in views of the fabulous French Riviera coastline and splash into the sea for a swim and snorkel. Our half-day sail includes a buffet lunch on board. We later return to our Riviera hotel for a free evening.

#### DAY 4 FRENCH RIVIERA | OPTIONAL SAINT-TROPEZ EXCURSION

Enjoy a free day. Relax on the beach, opt to rent a kayak or SUP, swim in the sparkling sea, or just shop until you drop. Consider exploring the casinos and night clubs later on this evening. You may want to join us on an exciting visit to glitzy Saint-Tropez, a coastal town known for its jet-set lifestyle boasting one of the liveliest social scenes along the coast. Our boat takes us on a one-hour journey along the seashore with lovely views. Upon arrival, we board a motor coach taking us to Chateau Minuty Gassin. This family-owned estate hand-picks all their grapes, assuring high-quality wines. After a tour of the grounds including a private house and a chapel dating back to the 19th-century, we will taste some of the winery's fabulous creations. Afterwards, explore the cobblestoned streets of la Ponch, the old fishing district of Saint-Tropez, and take time for lunch at a quaint bistro with fellow travelers. We return to our Riviera hotel for an evening at leisure.

#### DAY 5 NICE

In just under one hour our train whisks us to Nice, Queen resort of the Côte d'Azur. We'll start our exploration at Place Massena then venture along the charming streets of the old town with pastel-colored villas, boutiques and small shops including fragrant fromageries, boulangeries and various types of restaurants. Along the way we see the Opera House, Palais de Justice, Place Rossetti, and Castle Hill. Our French Brasserie dinner includes some unique local culinary treats for you to try. Before we head back to our hotel, take time to check out live music bars and clubs in the old town or take a walk on the breathtaking beachfront along the palm tree lined Promenade des Anglais.

#### DAY 6 EZE & MONTE CARLO

Get ready for a day filled with wonderful encounters for all of your senses. The picturesque hilltop village of Eze dates back to the Middle Ages and clings impressively to the mountainside above the Mediterranean Sea. Panoramic views, ancient façades and opulent gardens are some of the most memorable features of this lovely village. We'll tour the legendary perfume factory of Fragonard and visit the cosmetics laboratory where the brand's perfumes and other skin care products are made. After lunch continue to Monaco, home to the renowned Formula One Grand Prix. After Prince Rainier married American actress Grace Kelly, this sleepy town on the Mediterranean transformed into a fabled and glamorous metropolis. Enjoy the view of the town from La Turbie, known as the "Monaco terrace", then discover the old town, fantastic glimpses overlooking the harbor and see the Prince's Palace, before exploring the famous Monte Carlo Casino.

## DAY 7

### FRENCH RIVIERA | PROVENCE

We say 'adieu' to our Riviera home and board our private motor coach, taking us straight into Aix-en-Provence, a city of elegance. This open-air history book boasts a lovely Mediterranean climate, charming streets, and lively squares. The city's center is characterized by pastel buildings, bustling daily markets, and streets lined with irresistible shops. The sparkling skies, facades of elegant Renaissance mansions, splendid fountains, Provençal cuisine, and the gentle way of life make this city an icon of "bon vivre," how locals call "good living." Free time may find you exploring the local markets and savoring tapenade toast, tasting delicious cheeses, sipping on local wines, or tasting Nougat, the famous local sweet. This afternoon we discover the places where Paul Cézanne used to spend his days and fans of the Aix-born post-Impressionist artist will truly enjoy a tour of his studio. The evening is at leisure in Aix.

## DAY 8

### AIX-EN-PROVENCE: FREE DAY OR OPTIONAL EXCURSION TO VALENSOLE

Explore the charming town of Aix on your own today or join our optional all-day excursion to Valensole. From around mid-June to mid-August the region is brimming with the sights and smells of lavender – it's truly a spectacle not to be missed. The Valensole Plateau produces one of the best fields with endless stretches of fragrant rows and is likely the most visited and subsequently most photographed lavender growing region. On our bike ride through the purple-colored fields, we learn about the history of lavender production in the area, wander around a lavender farm and take some time to pose for selfies in the middle of a lavender field. After lunch in the village of Valensole, explore the boutiques and shops or try some lavender ice cream. Before returning to Aix, we visit a Lavender Distillery to learn about harvesting and oil extraction from the flowers and how the farms create their lavender products. There will be time to shop for local soaps, oils, bags, and perfumes to take home as souvenirs. Back in Aix-en-Provence, get ready for our farewell Riviera Magic dinner. Share the good times one last time before we say 'au revoir' and exchange contact information with new-found friends.

## TOUR DIRECTORS

Your tour includes the services of a professional tour director throughout the land package. We are very proud of our tour directors. ## HOTELS

Our hotels offer superior tourist class accommodations, with private bathrooms. Hotels are centrally located and many offer great extra amenities such as pools, gyms or roof-top bars. All land package rates are based on two people sharing a room. If a single room is desired, a supplement of \$795 applies. If traveling solo and not wanting to pay the single supplement, AESU will attempt to arrange a share with a same-gender traveler. If a share cannot be arranged the single supplement will apply.

# BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

**EXCLUSIONS:** These prices do not include passport and, if applicable, visa fees (Depending on your nationality, you may require visas in addition to a passport to enter certain countries. You must contact appropriate consulates for details on how to obtain on your own.); airport and government taxes; tipping of tour guide and driver (suggested \$5 per day for tour director, \$2-3 per day for driver); beverages with meals unless indicated otherwise; laundry; personal insurance; room service; telephone charges; all items of a personal nature; any vaccinations, pre/post trip testing/screening, airport transfers when a participant deviates from scheduled flights or travel dates; private transportation; and all items not specifically stated in the itinerary.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** All cancellations must be received by AESU in writing. Date of receipt will determine penalties assessed. Cancellation from time of booking until 120 days prior to departure will result in a \$300 cancellation fee. Cancellation between 119-90 days of departure will result in forfeiture of 25% of tour cost; between 89-60 days 35% of tour cost; between 59-30 days 50% of tour cost. Cancellation within 30 days of departure or a "no-show" at the time of departure will result in forfeiture of the entire cost of the trip. Processing of cancellation refunds takes approximately 6-8 weeks.

**AIRFARES** are highly restrictive, NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-ENDORSABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE once ticketed. Once reservation is booked and paid for AESU reserves the right to issue tickets. Once ticketed, airfare portion is non-refundable. Cancellation of airfare reservations is subject to restrictions, regulations and additional penalties of the airlines used. Reservation changes are also subject to penalties. Travel insurance, including medical health and accident coverage, is compulsory. PLEASE SEE WEBSITE FOR POSSIBLE ADDITIONS TO CANCELLATION POLICIES LISTED ABOVE DEPENDING ON TRIP DESTINATION.

**AIRPORT TRANSFERS AND BAGGAGE:** All participants using AESU flights on regular group departure days and flights receive airport transfers (between airport & tour hotel) overseas. Land-Only participants (providing own flight overseas) do NOT receive airport transfers and must meet group at the first hotel after 3:00 p.m. on program start date. **FLIGHT DELAYS - ALL AIRPORTS:** In the event that airline schedule changes or delays force you to miss your airport transfer, just make your way to the first hotel listed on your hotel list. Many shuttle services are available as well as taxi or train options. As airline delays are beyond the control of AESU, additional expenses, if incurred, will be borne by the tour participant. (Save receipts for possible reimbursement by airline.) AESU is not responsible if an airline cancels, reschedules, or delays a flight for any reason. If you miss your departure flight, it is your responsibility to work with the airline on which you are ticketed to reach your destination. AESU is not responsible for any additional expenses you may incur prior to joining your trip. AESU is not responsible for and will not provide any refund for portions of trips missed due to canceled, rescheduled, or delayed flights. Participants should limit themselves to one checked bag per person and one carry-on per person. Check your airline's website for any additional luggage restrictions. Liability is clearly stated on the passenger contract.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** The responsibility of AESU as a tour operator, their agents, and any sponsoring association is limited. They act only in the capacity of agents for the passenger in all matters pertaining to accommodations, sightseeing and transportation whether by railroad, motorboat, motorcar, steamship or plane, and as such they shall not be liable for any personal injury, death, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity which may be occasioned, whether by reason of any defect in any vehicle, or through the acts or default of any company or person engaged in conveying the passenger, or in carrying out the arrangement of the tour. They can accept no responsibility for strike, war, quarantine, epidemic health risk, any force majeure event, weather and any other natural or unnatural causes. Additional expenses, if incurred under any of these circumstances, will be borne by the tour participant. By forwarding the deposit, the passenger certifies that he/she has no physical, mental or other condition or disability that would create a hazard for himself/ herself or other passengers & accepts the terms of this contract. The right is reserved to decline, accept or retain any person as a member of the tour or to cancel or alter the tour as required. If improvements in the itinerary can be made, or unforeseen conditions beyond the Operator's control make changes necessary, they reserve the right to alter itineraries without penalty. **TRAVEL INSURANCE** is compulsory in the event of tour cancellation for any reason, medical expenses, personal accident, baggage and other personal items, liability and 24-hr emergency assistance. Trip insurance may be offered directly by your Alumni Association. In the event of cancellation due to insufficient number of participants, the Operator's liability shall be limited to a refund of land payments received from applicants, except non-refundable airfare and insurance. If the change or cancellation is due to force majeure or other similar events beyond Operator's control, a refund of land payments received from applicants will be made less reasonable expenses incurred by Operator in respect to applicant's land booking. Baggage and personal injury are at owner's risk entirely. The issuance or acceptance of vouchers or tickets shall be considered consent of the above conditions. The Operator reserves the right to increase the program price in the event of cost increases due to changes in airfares, currency fluctuations or fuel surcharges.
